
## What is a Traineeship Project?

A period of work practice that a young person can carry out to develop professional skills and learn behaviour which is appropriate to the working environment. It is a unique opportunity for a young person to gain experience and make a start on the labour market, while contributing to address important societal challenges and bringing about positive change to the local community.

The project can last from six to 24 months and an individual traineeship placement can be from two to 6 months (excluding travel time), either in-country or cross-border.

The project should address key challenges within the community and be related to European Solidarity Corps wider topics below such as:


- Solidarity
