
What is a Job Project?

A period of employment (in line with the national regulatory framework), during which a young person can enhance their skills and experience thus facilitating their employability and transition into the labour market, while contributing to address important societal challenges and bringing about positive change to the local community.

The project can last from six to 24 months and an individual job placement can be from three to 12 months (excluding travel time), either in-country or cross-border.

The project should address key challenges within the community and be related to European Solidarity Corps wider topics below such as:

- Solidarity
- Democracy and citizenship
- Societal challenges
- Strengthening communities
- Social inclusion

Activities

What activities will the job involve? How will the activities be relevant to the project's overall aims and objectives? How will the activities enable the achievement of the planned learning outcomes?



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
